high level of achievement may have been maintained under difficult conditions relat^d to family, outside endeavors, employment and other situations. **In 2018 twenty scholarships were awarded.**

Project Shoe



Project Shoe is unique in that although the program pr[vides shoes and sc@ol supplies to the children in need in our community, the program strives to develop, within the children, an understanding that this is a helping hand and not a handout. The program builds on improvi} g self-esteem and changing their attitudes toward learning. The students t@at participate in Pr[ject Shoe range in

age from 2 to 6 years old and are all eligible for free school lunc@es. In 2017 ninety one children participated in the program including children from military families.

Prosthetic Hands Project



The project was developed in anÁassociation with the Kiwa} is and PVNet, a 22 year old established emerging technology center. PVNet fabricated the parts and provided the facilities for the proj^ct. Young aåults from the dree local hagh schools, Peninsula, Palos Verdes and Mary Star, met at the Palo• Verdes on the Net (PVNet) Education & Technology Center to assemble ten pr[sthetic hands as a one day Kiwanis project. The students were all m^mbers of one of the Kiwanis on campus

service clubs, the Key Club or the KIWINS. The prosthetic hands were donated to Enable Community Foundation who will t@an distribute the hands to needy children who have lost their fingers due to accident, disaster or birth...**In 2017 ten prosthetic hands were donated.**

The Boys & Girls Club Christmas Party



The holidays traditionally pose an e¢tra challenge for families in neeå, especially for the children. Physiologically, think how devastating it would be too receive nothing while all their friends received a new toy. A Christmas in poverty does have an impact on these children in need. EveryÁDecember we gather with childr^n from Volunteers of America and The Boys & Girls Club at the Boys and Girls Club in Haràor City. The children are 5-7 years old and we provide a Santæ food, toys a D.J. playãng Christmas music, and

an activity in which they give back by making a gi-t for their family. The families who are chosen are the most in need of financa al assistance and we want to make sure the children have Ágifts over the holidays. In 2017 fifty children participated in the program.


